**Sub: Release of provisional Grants-in-aid to State Health Society Maharashtra, Mumbai under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Mainstreaming of AYUSH under NRHM, 2010-11 - Reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for the payment of **Rs.9,36,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakh Thirty Six Thousand Only)** as Grants-in-aid to the State Health Society Maharashtra, Mumbai under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Mainstreaming of AYUSH under NRHM for the setting up of Programme Management Unit (PMU) for twelve months and to release **Rs.4,68,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Sixty Eight Thousand Only)** as 50% Central Government share for the implementation of the Scheme. The balance 50% share shall be provided by the State Government of Maharashtra.

2. The Programme Management Unit shall appoint the following personnel on contractual basis and pay to PMU staff as per Scheme provision:-

3. The State Government shall take over the entire expenditure on the PMU by the end of the 11<sup>th</sup> Plan.

4. The above amount is in accordance with the instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance (Plan Finance Division) vide their O.M. Bo. 10(1) PF-1/76 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 1977 and as amended from time to time.

5. The Grant-in-aid now sanctioned is provisional and is subject to adjustment on the basis of audited figures of expenditure in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, letter No. 2 (90) -P-II/66 dated 9.10.1966 and as amended from time to time.

6. The expenditure shall be incurred in respect of Plan heads of Accounts under the provision of GFR-2005/DFPR-1978/Receipts and Payments Rules 1983 and for the purpose for which it was sanctioned as clearly specified in para (1&2) of above.

7. The Grant-in-aid shall be subject to the conditions laid down in GFR-2005 and the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time.

The Grantee institution shall utilize the grants-in-aid and submit the actual Utilization Certificate of this grant within twelve months of the closure of the financial year in the prescribed GFR19-A format along with the expenditure statement in the prescribed format, audited statement of accounts, Achievement-cum-Performance Report and Taxation shall be applicable as per Law.
9. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out the Grants shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority.
10. It is certified that the amount of grant sanctioned above is within the budget provision accepted for the purpose by the Ministry of Finance for the financial year 2010-11.
11. The accounts of the grantee institution/organization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit both by the CAG of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) act, 1971 and internal auditing of the O/o CCA of the ministry, whenever the institution or organization is called upon to do so.
12. The expenditure involved will be met from the funds provided under the Head: 2210-Medical and Public Health (Major Head); 02200—Other Systems (Minor head); 30-Development of AYUSH Hospitals & Dispensaries and Mainstreaming of AYUSH; 300031-Grant-in-aid-General for recurring head under the Demand No.47-Department of AYUSH for the year 2010-11.
