Sub: Policy decision for processing of the cases of ASU^{UG} Colleges for grant/denial of permission for the academic session 2013-14 in view of the new MSR Regulations.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the CCIM's letter F.No.11-140/2012-Admission dated 03.05.2013 and the meeting convened in the Department of AYUSH with the officials of CCIM on 08.05.2013. The MSR Regulations for Ayurveda Colleges were published on 19.07.2012 in the Gazette of India with the subsequent amendment published on 23.04.2013. The MSR Regulations for Unani & Siddha Colleges have also been published on 20.02.2013 in the Gazette of India. As per all these MSR Regulations, the hospital data is to be taken of last one calendar year for consideration of grant/denial of permissions from the session 2013-14 onwards. Other issues like slab of intake capacity and age of teachers appointed/continued between 19.7.2012 and 22.04.2013 in Ayurveda Colleges are also to be considered as per these new MSR Regulations and amendment in MSR Regulations.

2. In view of the above circumstances, the following decision has been taken by the Central Government for processing of the cases of ASU Colleges for grant/denial of permission for the academic session 2013-14 in light of the new MSR Regulations:

(3)	Minimum per day average number of patients in OPD	<p>For Ayurveda Colleges:- From 01.01.2012 to 18.07.2012 (164 days out of total 200 days @300 days in a calendar year) as per policy norms of 2012-13, minimum 100 patients per day (minimum 16400 patients for this period for intake capacity of any slab) and from 19.07.2012 to 31.12.2012 (total 166 days @365 days in a calendar year) as per MSR for intake capacity upto 60 seats and 61 to 100 seats, minimum 120 and 200 patients per day respectively (minimum 19920 and 33200 patients for this period for intake capacity upto 60 seats and 61 to 100 seats respectively) in OPD. Therefore, total minimum 36320 patients for intake capacity upto 60 seats and total minimum 49600 patients in OPD for intake capacity from 61 to 100 seats for the period of assessment of hospital data i.e. from 01.01.2012 to 31.12.2012.</p> <p>For Siddha & Unani Colleges:- From 01.01.2012 to 31.12.2012 (total 300 days) as per policy norms of 2012-13, minimum 100 patients per day in OPD for intake capacity of any slab (total minimum 30000 patients in OPD for this period).</p>
(4)	Minimum number of Beds in IPD for calculation of bed occupancy for the year 2012	<p>For Ayurveda Colleges:- The beds in IPD for calculation of bed occupancy from 01.01.2012 to 18.07.2012, as per policy norms of 2012-13, minimum 100 beds for upto 50 seats and 1:2 beds for additional seats and from 19.07.2012 to 31.12.2012 as per MSR, for intake capacity upto 60 seats and 61 to 100 seats, minimum 60 and 100 beds respectively.</p> <p>For Siddha Colleges:- The beds in IPD for calculation of bed occupancy from 01.01.2012 to 31.12.2012, as per policy norms of 2012-13, minimum 100 beds for upto 50 seats and 1:2 beds for additional seats.</p> <p>For Unani Colleges:- The beds in IPD for calculation of bed occupancy from 01.01.2012 to 31.12.2012, as per policy norms of 2012-13, minimum 50 beds for upto 50 seats and 1:1 beds for additional seats.</p>
(5)	Age of Teachers	<p>For Ayurveda Colleges:- The eligibility of teacher will be counted as follows: i. The teacher having age above 65 and below 70 years, appointed/continuing between 19.07.2012 to 22.04.2013, will be considered eligible limited to the session 2013-14 only; and/or ii. The teacher having age below 65 before 18.07.2012, after 23.04.2013 and in between this period will be considered eligible.</p> <p>For Siddha & Unani Colleges:- The teacher having age below 65 years will be considered eligible.</p>

3. The CCIM is requested to take into consideration the above-mentioned policy decision of the Central Government on these 5 requirements while forwarding their recommendations and reports of the ASU Colleges for grant/denial of permission for the academic session 2013-14. **All other requirements are to be taken into consideration as per the concerned MSR and UG/PG regulations for ASU colleges.** The CCIM is further requested to furnish their recommendations and reports of all ASU Colleges by 31st July, 2013 positively so that the further processing of the cases for grant/denial of permission to the ASU Colleges may be completed by the Department well in time.

4. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
