NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 16th March, 1998

G.S.R. 136(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and supersession of the Central Government Health Scheme and the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine and Homoeopathy Group 'A' posts Recruitment Rules, 1995, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Indian System of Medicine and Homocopathy Group 'A' Posts in the Central Government Health Scheme and the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine and Homocopathy, including attached and subordinate offices, New Delhi, namely:

1 **Short title and commencement** :—(1) These rules may be called the Central Government Health Scheme and the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine and Homocopathy Group 'A' Posts Recruitment Rules, 1997

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2 **Application** :—These rules shall apply to the posts specified the column 1 of the Schedule, annexed to these rules

3 **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay** :—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4 **Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.** :—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the schedule aforesaid

5 **Disqualification** :—No person (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other persons, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6 **Power to relax** :—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7 **Saving** :—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxations of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
