Sub. : Policy regarding matter of grant of permission to Post Graduate courses in ASU Systems.

Sir,

I am directed to inform that the calculation of the IPD bed occupancy for grant of permission to Post Graduate courses in ASU Systems may be considered with reduced admission capacity without diluting the norm of 50% IPD bed occupancy. The IPD occupancy may be calculated by reducing the number of beds which is required for the number of seats in the PG course(s) for which permission may be considered subject to requirements like minimum number of beds to conduct PG courses, staff and infrastructure are available in the institute for the course(s). This is uniformly applicable to all eligible ASU institutes from the academic session 2012-13.
