Sub: Minimum Standards Norms for conditional permission to ASU colleges for the academic session 2012-13 - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to inform that the Government has decided that the norms and criteria for granting conditional permission to ASU colleges for the academic year 2012-13 will be exactly the same as have been followed for the academic year 2011-12.

2. In this connection, kindly note that the norms and criteria for 2011-12 which are being made applicable for the academic year 2012-13 are contained in our two letters having No. R.11011/05/2010-EP dated 18.03.2011 and 21.03.2011, dealing respectively with the norms for permission, and the procedure for consideration. It is specifically reiterated that as followed during 2011-12 in pursuance of the policy contained in the letter No. R.11011/05/2010-EP dated 21.03.2011, the Government shall not be considering any data with respect to teachers or hospital functioning beyond the date of CCIM's visitation/inspection.

3. It may be noted that while applying the 2011-12 guidelines and procedure, the data to be taken into account for consideration will clearly relate to the data for the hospital functioning for the period 1.1.2011 to 31.12.2011.

4. In following the norms regarding teachers for 2011-12, some doubts were expressed from different quarters regarding the precise requirement of teachers for different streams of medicine. It is clarified that exactly the same norms will be followed for the forthcoming academic year 2012-13 as had been followed in the current academic year 2011-12 i.e. requirement of teachers will continue to be as follows:

5. Further, in view of the late receipt of CCIM's visitation report and recommendations, the process of grant of permission including hearing consumes long time. Therefore, with the objective to finalize the process for granting/denial of permission at the earliest before beginning of the academic session, the Central Government has decided that CCIM should start the inspection of all colleges immediately and complete the same by 15th February, 2012. The recommendations of CCIM for each college should be submitted to the Central Government as soon as inspection for that college is over, and all recommendations should reach Government by 15th March, 2012, so that, the process of examination of CCIM's recommendations, hearing (if required) and granting permission/denial may be completed by the Central Government at the earliest. CCIM in this regard is requested to cooperate effectively. The last date of admission will however continue to remain same i.e. 31st October, 2012.
