

FITM-AYUSH Fellowships for Doctoral and Postdoctoral Research at RIS

The Forum on Indian Traditional Medicine (FITM), established at Research & Information System for Developing Countries (RIS), New Delhi as part of the initiative of Ministry of AYUSH and RIS to contribute towards pragmatic policy making in the area of Indian Traditional Medicines (ITMs), invites applications from full-time PhD scholars (registered with recognised Indian Universities/Institutes) and PhD degree holders for Doctoral and Postdoctoral Research Fellowships respectively.

Selected candidates will undertake systems research that explores economic, sociological, politico-economic, trade, management, and/or IT/digital technology related aspects of Indian Traditional Medicine Systems with the aim of national and global promotion of these systems.

The fellowship is **Not Applicable** to studies relating to clinical, pharmacological and pharmacognosy and other related research areas.

ELIGIBILITY: The Doctoral and Postdoctoral Research Fellowships are open to scholars with educational backgrounds in any of AYUSH disciplines. Additional qualification in any other specialisation especially IT is desirable. Outstanding candidates from other disciplines may be considered.

DURATION:

Two Years (Doctoral Fellowships)

One year (Postdoctoral Fellowship)

All inclusive maximum amount of upto Rs 5 lakh/- per year for Doctoral Fellowships

All inclusive maximum amount of upto Rs 7.5 lakh/- per year for Postdoctoral Fellowship
