

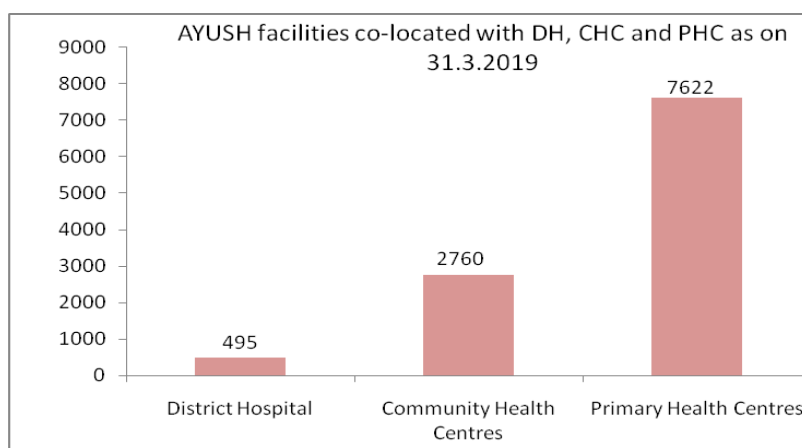
## SECTION 6: INTEGRATION OF AYUSH IN THE HEALTH CARE SYSTEM UNDER NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION (NHM)

After the launch of NHM, an initiative has been taken by the Department of Health & Family Welfare and Ministry of AYUSH for strengthening of health care facilities at all levels by integrating AYUSH systems in national health care delivery systems under NHM.

Physical and functional integration of AYUSH systems in NHM is most important strategy of Mainstreaming under NHM. Integration is facilitated by appointing or collocating AYUSH doctors & supporting staff and creating infrastructure according to local needs. AYUSH doctors who are being appointed are used to facilitate management of programmes, monitoring and effective implementation of various interventions under NHM.

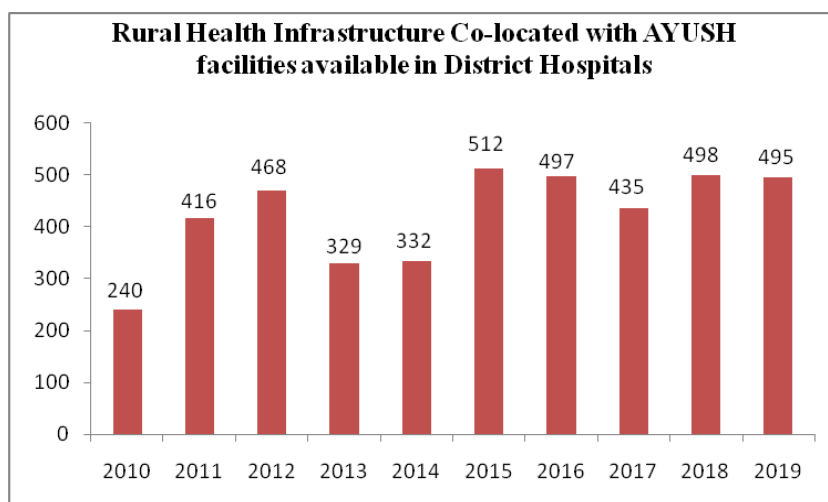
As on March, 2019, there are 701 districts, 4998 blocks and 640867 villages incorporating 764 District Hospitals (DHs), 5624 Community Health Centres (CHCs) and 25743 Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in India. The rural population of India for 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2019 has been estimated as 8833.54 lakhs. On an average, 17.8 lakhs, 3.2 lakhs and 1.2 lakhs rural population has been served per co-located AYUSH facilities of District hospital, Community Health Centre, Primary Health Centre respectively.

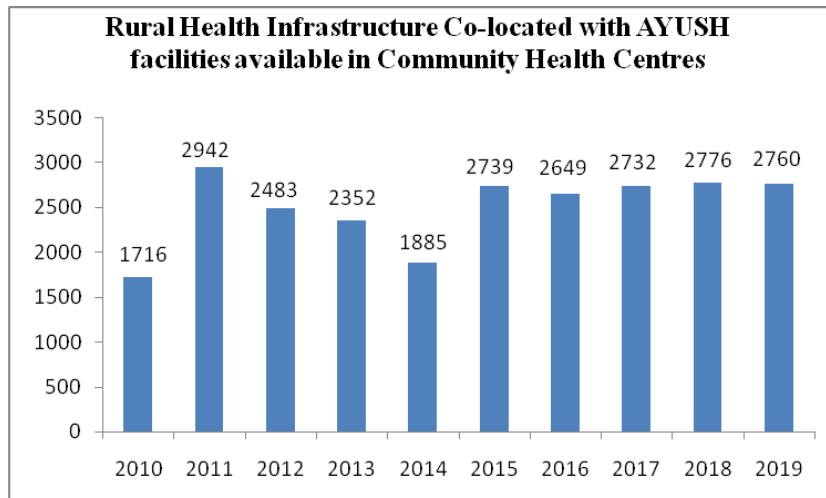
AYUSH facilities has been co-located with 495 District Hospitals, 2760 Community Health Centre's and 7622 Primary Health Centre's in the country as on 31.03.2019. AYUSH facilities has also been co-located with 371 'Other than CHC or above block level but below district level and with 3923 'Other health facilities above SC but below block level.

### Co-location Rate of Rural Health Infrastructure with AYUSH facilities in India:



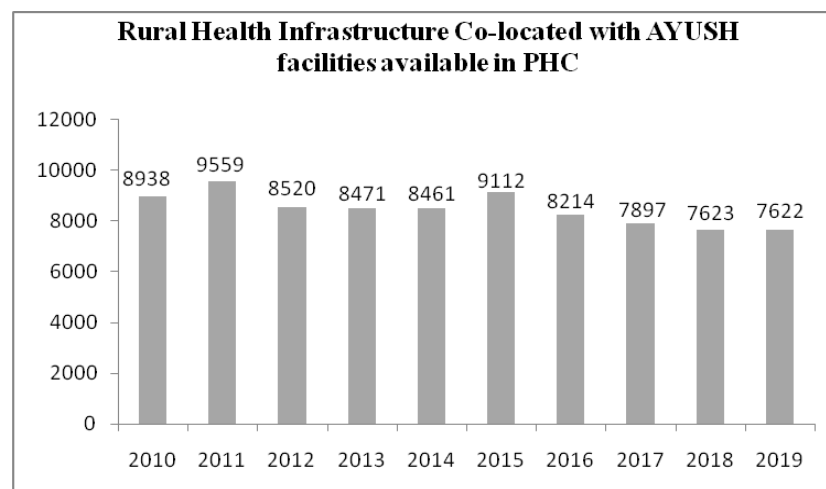
About 64.8% District hospitals has been co-located with AYUSH facilities till 2019. All the District hospitals existing in the states and union territories of Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Goa, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Manipur, Mizoram, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, A & N Islands, Chandigarh and Daman & Diu has been co-located with AYUSH facilities, whereas, the states having 50% or more District hospitals co-located with AYUSH facilities are Chhattisgarh,

Delhi, Harayana, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Bengal and Puducherry.



Nearly 49.1% Community Health Centre's has been co-located with AYUSH facilities till 2019. All the CHCs existing in the states and union territories of Goa, Manipur, Mizoram, Tamil Nadu, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu and Puducherry has been co-located. The states having 50% or more CHCs co-located with AYUSH facilities are Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Nagaland Odisha,

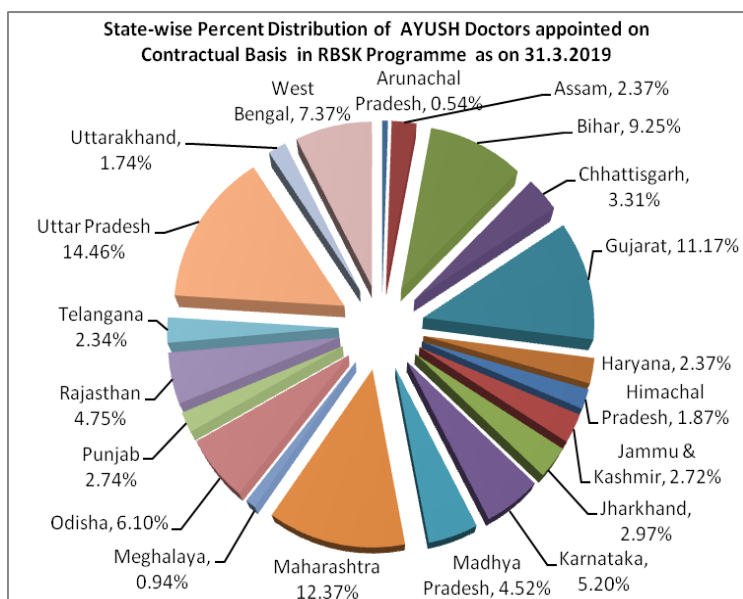
Sikkim, Telangana, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and West Bengal. The states having less than 25% CHCs co-located with AYUSH facilities are Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir and Karnataka. No co-location of AYUSH facilities has been observed in CHCs in the remaining states and union territories i.e. Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Delhi, Kerala and Lakshadweep.



About 29.6% Primary Health Centre's has been co-located with AYUSH facilities till 2019. All the PHC existing in the State of Goa and Union Territory of Delhi, Chandigarh, D&N Haveli and Puducherry have been co-located. The States/ union territories having 50% or more PHCs co-located with AYUSH facilities are Chhattisgarh, Jammu & Kashmir, Manipur, Meghalaya, Odisha, Telangana, Tripura, A&N Islands and Daman & Diu. States having more than 25% but less than 50% PHCs

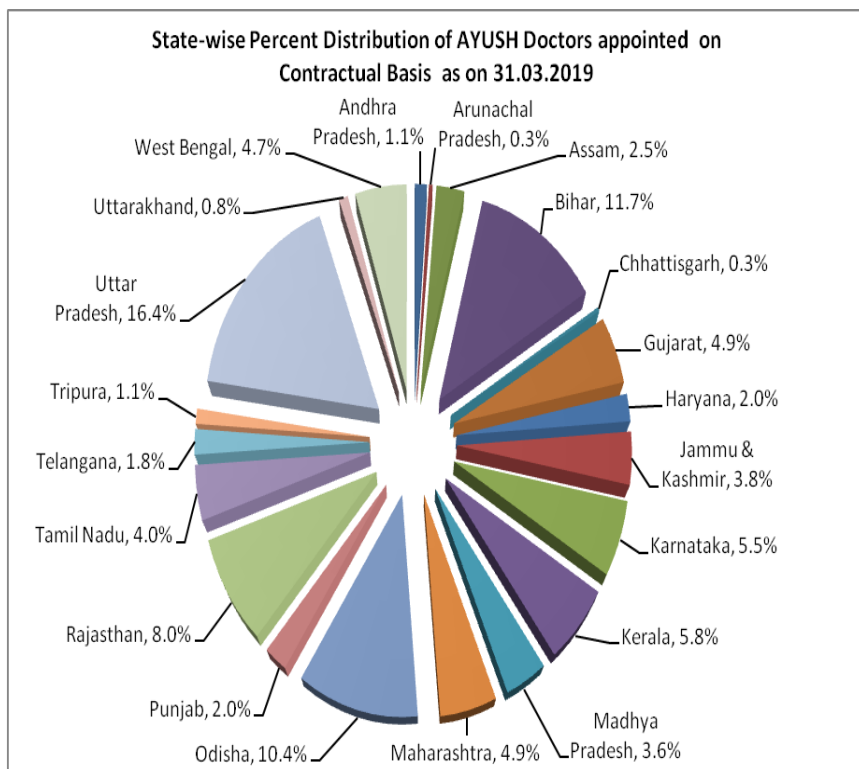
co-located with AYUSH facilities are Gujarat, Harayana, Jharkhand, Karanataka, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu. No co-location with AYUSH facilities has been observed in the PHCs in the remaining states and union territories i.e. Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Kerala and Lakshadweep.

**Table 6.5 Contractual Appointment of AYUSH Doctors and Paramedical Staff in India:**



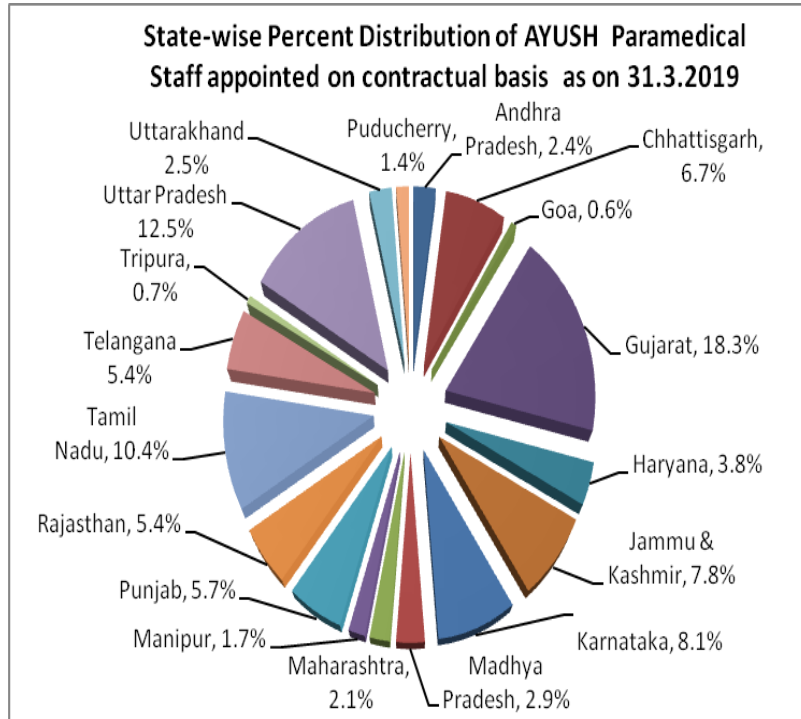
As on 31.03.2019, contractual appointment of 15627 AYUSH Doctors in RBSK Programme, 11837 AYUSH Doctors and 4549 AYUSH Paramedical staff has been recorded. Maximum 2270 AYUSH Doctors in RBSK Programme are appointed in the State of Uttar Pradesh whereas 1942, 1745, 1446 and 1151 contractual appointments of AYUSH Doctors in RBSK Programme has been observed in the states of Maharashtra, Gujarat, Bihar and West Bengal respectively. States having contractual AYUSH Doctor in RBSK Programme ranging from 500 to 1000 are Odisha, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh. The States having more than 250 and less than 500 contractual appointment

doctors in RBSK Programme are Assam, Harayana, Himachal, J&K, Jharkhand, Punjab, Telangana and Uttarakhand. Andhra Pradesh, Delhi, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Lakshadweep are the only States/UTs where there is no contractual AYUSH Doctor in RBSK Programme.



Maximum contractual appointment of 1945 AYUSH Doctors has been recorded in the State of Uttar Pradesh whereas 1384 and 1235 contractual appointments of AYUSH Doctors has been observed in the states of Bihar and Odisha respectively. States having contractual Doctors ranging from 500 to 1000 are Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and West Bengal. The States having more than 250 and less than 500 contractual appointment doctors are Assam, J&K, Madhya Pradesh, and Tamil Nadu. Delhi is the only States/UTs where there is no contractual AYUSH Doctor.

Likewise, 4549 contractual appointments of AYUSH Paramedical Staff are recorded till date 31.03.2019. Maximum 834 Paramedical Staff is appointed in the state of Gujarat, whereas 569, 475, 367, 353 and 304 Paramedical Staff appointed in, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka J&K and Chhattisgarh respectively. In states of Punjab, Rajasthan and Telangana contractual appointed paramedical staff are ranging from 200 to 300. In Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, West Bengal and D & N Haveli, no AYUSH Paramedical Staffs appointment has been done till date 31.03.2019.



**Table 6.6 Number of AYUSH Doctors**

As on 31.03.2019, there are 13347 AYUSH Doctors at PHCs and 3197 AYUSH Doctors at CHCs has been recorded. Maximum 4209 AYUSH Doctors at PHCs are appointed in the State of Uttar Pradesh whereas 1803 and 1273 AYUSH Doctors at PHCs are appointed in the State of Bihar and Gujarat respectively. States having AYUSH Doctor at PHCs ranging from 500 to 1000 are Assam, Odisha, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh. The States having more than 250 and less than 500 AYUSH doctors at PHCs are Jammu & Kashmir, Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu. Karnataka, Chandigarh and Delhi are the only States/UTs where there is no AYUSH Doctor at PHC.

Maximum 597 AYUSH Doctors at CHCs are appointed in the State of Uttar Pradesh whereas 527 AYUSH Doctors at CHCs are appointed in the state of Jharkhand. States having AYUSH doctors at CHCs ranging from 250- 500 are Tamil Nadu and Odisha. The States having more than 100 and less than 250 AYUSH doctors at CHCs are Rajasthan, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Punjab, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh. Kerala, A & N Islands, Chandigarh, Daman & Diu and Delhi are the only States/UTs where no AYUSH Doctors at CHCs has been recorded till date 31.03.2019.
