

CONTINUATION OF CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEME OF NATIONAL AYUSH MISSION

- The Government of India has approved the continuation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) from 01-04-2021 to 31-03-2026 with a financial implication of ₹ 4607.30 Crore (₹ 3000.00 Crore as Central Share and ₹ 1607.30 Crore as State Share).
- The National AYUSH Mission is being implemented with the Objective to provide cost effective AYUSH Services, by upgrading AYUSH Hospitals, Dispensaries and Ayush educational institutions, co-location of AYUSH systems at Public Health facilities, and setting up of new up to 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital and teaching institutions.
- The operationalization of the 12,500 AYUSH Health and Wellness Centres component under AYUSHMAN BHARAT for implementation through National AYUSH Mission will also be continued. In addition, new Ayush Public Health programs will also be part of the National AYUSH Mission.
- The Mission is addressing the gaps in health services through supporting the efforts of State/UT Governments for providing AYUSH health services/education in the country, particularly in vulnerable and far-flung areas. It is expected to have better access to AYUSH healthcare services through increased healthcare facilities offering holistic health.
