**Subject: Preparation of Panel for Engagement of Consultants on contract basis in the Ministry of AYUSH- reg.**

The undersigned is directed to say that National Medicinal Plants Division, Ministry of AYUSH proposes to prepare a panel of Consultants for engagement on Contract basis. Persons retired from the post of Under Secretary or equivalent in the Govt. of India, State Governments, Attached & Subordinate Offices, PSUs, Autonomous Bodies of the Govt. of India are eligible for the position of the Consultant. 2.	Period of engagement	Initially for a period one year. May further be extended on year to year basis, subject to functional requirements and also subject to appraisal of the performance.
3.	Age limit	Should not be more than 64 years of age on the last date for receipt of application. The age ceiling for continuation of contract shall be 65 years as on the date of renewal of contract year to year basis.
4.	Remuneration payable	Rs. 50,000/-
5.	Place of work	National Medicinal Plant Board, Red Cross Building, New Delhi
6.	Specialisation in	Administration/Establishment matters, Budget, Policy matters
