**NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT) FOR SELECTION OF AGENCY FOR
CONCEPTUALIZATION, OPERATIONALIZATION AND CONDUCT OF
INTERNATIONAL YOGA LEAGUE FOR THE YEAR 2017-18 ON BEHALF
OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA, MINISTRY OF AYUSH**

1. Overview

1.1 Definitions

- i. **“Employers”** means the Ministry of AYUSH
- ii. **“Contract”** means the Contract signed by the Parties and all the attached documents listed in its Clause 1, that is the General Conditions (GC), the project Specific Conditions (SC), and the Appendices.
- iii. **“Project Specific information”** means such part of the Instruction to bidders used to reflect specific project and assignment conditions.
- iv. **“Day”** means calendar day.
- v. **“Government”** means Government of India.
- vii. **“Personnel”** means professionals and support staff provided by the bidder or by any implementing agency and assigned to perform the Services or any part thereof;
- viii. **“Bid”** means the Technical Bid and the Financial Bid.
- ix. **“Assignment / Job”** means the work to be performed by selected bidder pursuant to the contract.
- x. **“Agency”** means a business organization providing a particular service and registered company under the Indian Laws or an NGO registered in India.
- xi. **“Successful Bidder”** means the bidder AGENCY which selected for award of Assignment/ job.
- xii. **“Implementing Agency”** means any agency, contractor or entity with whom the selected bidder subcontracts any part of the Assignment/ Job.
- xiii. **“Terms of Reference”** (TOR) means the details included in the NIT specifically in Para 2 or otherwise as well as the contract which explains the objectives, scope of work, activities, tasks to be performed, respective responsibilities of the Employer and the selected bidder, and expected results and deliverables of the Assignment/ Job.

1.2 Introduction: Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India, for and on behalf of President of India, invites bids from eligible agencies for engagement as agency for works relating to conceptualization, operationalization and conduct of **International Yoga League (IYL) 2017-18.**

2. Terms of Reference and Scope of Works:

2.1 **Terms of Reference:** Terms of reference of the selected agency will broadly include conceptualization; operationalization and conduct of IYL 2017-18. The broad activities will include the following:

- i. Preparation of the concept plan and IYL format
- ii. Getting the plan and format approved by the Ministry of AYUSH
- iii. Monitoring, supervision and facilitation of the implementation of the plan, including fulfillment of all statutory/legal requirements
- iv. Selection of IYL teams, format for competition, selection of Jury
- v. Training, mentoring, supporting the participants, teams as well as Jury including Yoga suits, films/dance celebrity, Sports personality etc,
- vi. Media management especially the popular television, publicity and social media
- vii. Management of revenue especially from gate collection and media telecast rights. Payment of the revenue share to the Ministry as per Service Level Agreement. The whole league is to be completed within three months.
- viii. Submitting reports of progress of the IYL from time to time to the Ministry of AYUSH.
- ix. Submitting the final report and statement of accounts to the Ministry of AYUSH and foot-print for the next year's IYL
- x. Any other item of work that is incidental to and essential for conduct of IYL (to be included in the form of Contract Agreement after due consultation between both the parties).

2.2 Brief scope of work:

- i. Scope of work includes formatting the IYL competition. Making it popular on the entertainment media. Generate revenue so that the IYL is gross earner while popularizing the Yoga amongst all sections of the society.
- ii. It would be the endeavor of the agency to inculcate international flavor of the IYL. Stress would also be on standardization of the Yoga practices, making Yoga artistic and inspirational by innovating themes like *Yoga and Music*, *Yoga and Health*, *Yoga and Wellness*, *Yoga and Entertainment* etc.

- iii. Finding partners for the league like franchise owners, league execution agencies, TV partners etc.
- iv. Creation of a detailed communication plan for the league.
- v. Creation of a timeline for various league mile stone events.
- vi. Creation of sponsorship packages, franchise packages and TV partner packages.
- vii. For this purpose, agency will also maintain close liaison with Yoga Gurus and Ashrams. Most of the Jury will be from such Yoga schools or Ashrams or any Yoga expert of eminence.
- viii. Agency will also have to work closely with the entertainment media so that the revenue generation is optimized and IYL becomes self-sustaining league with surplus.
- ix. Total span of League is likely to be three years and beyond. However, the franchise will be decided for the first year and the selected agency may opt to continue for next two years on same terms & conditions subject to approval of Ministry of AYUSH.

3. Eligibility:

The agency should meet the Financial and Technical eligibility criteria (Quality Evolution Criteria) as per parameters laid down here under:

4. Clarifications on NIT Document:

4.2 Pre-Bid conference will be held at 11:00 Hrs on 20.03.2017 in the Conference hall, Ground Floor, AYUSH Bhawan, Ministry of AYUSH, 'B' Block, GPO Complex, INA, New Delhi - 110023. All efforts will be made to furnish clarification during the pre-Bid Conference. In exceptional cases, the same will be furnished subsequently. In both cases, the minutes of the pre-bid meeting containing clarifications shall be posted on the website of the Ministry of AYUSH.

4.3 Any clarifications issued by Ministry of AYUSH shall be an integral part of this document and shall amount to an amendment to the relevant clauses of this document.

5. Documents / details to be submitted in the Offer:

5.1 The agency is required to furnish the following details / documents duly signed and stamped on each page by the authorized signatory of the agency:

- i. Technical Details about the agency and other relevant information in the formats prescribed at **Annexure III to VIII** including documents in the

details provided therein. (Such information shall form the basis of technical evaluation).

- ii. Certificate of Incorporation / Registration.
- iii. Copy of aims and objectives of the AGENCY as indicated in the Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association of the AGENCY.
- iv. Annual reports and audited statement or statements certified by an independent auditor appointed by the company; of accounts for the last three years (2013-14 to 2015-16). Certificates in support of the turnover from the statutory auditors of the company certifying the turnover and profit.
- v. Copy of Certificates for Services Tax and copy of PAN and TAN.
- vi. Copy of NIT & clarification issued by Ministry of AYUSH to this NIT, if any, as a mark of acceptance of all conditions of the NIT.
- vii. A certificate from the Chairman/ Company Secretary of the agency certifying the details of the signatory authority and attestation of such authority's signature or Power of Attorney in favor of the signatory authority for the purpose of signing bid documents.
- viii. A detailed write-up on the agency's Approach and Methodology to perform the assignment based on the TOR.

Note:

- a. All papers / documents must be self attested (with stamp) by authorized signatory.
- b. Each page of the proposal should be duly numbered and total number of pages in the proposal should be clearly mentioned in the proposal. Index of the documents submitted in the NIT should be given and location of the documents submitted should be clearly mentioned in the index, so that the tender evaluation committee is able to easily locate them. Non-compliance of this condition will result in rejection of the bid.
- c. All monetary figures should be in INR.
- d. Only proposals complete in all respects and containing all requisite documents/ information/ data shall be accepted and evaluated. Proposals which are incomplete or lacking in any manner shall be declared "not responsive" and summarily rejected and no requests for condonation/ acceptance of information after the final date for submission of tender documents shall be entertained.

6. Earnest Money Deposit:

6.1 To safeguard the interests of the Government, each bid will be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit of **Rs. 10.00 Lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs only)**. Earnest Money can be Deposited along with the technical bid by means of Bank Guarantee/ Demand Draft/ Banker's Cheque (**in the respective format enclosed as Annexure I**) drawn in favour of the **Pay and Accounts Officer (Sectt.), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare**, at Delhi/New Delhi. The Earnest Money Deposit shall have to be valid for at **least six months**. Technical bids not accompanied by Earnest Money or Earnest Money in deviation from above shall be summarily rejected. No interest shall be payable by the Employer for the sum deposited as EMD. Exemption to MSME may be considered if the proposal is accompanied with a sanction from MSME Department.

6.2 Earnest Money will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders without interest as soon as practicable after a decision on Bids.

6.3 The Earnest Money shall be liable for forfeiture in the following events:

- I. If proposal is withdrawn during the validity period or any extension agreed by the bidder thereof.
- II. If the proposal is varied or modified in a manner not acceptable to the employer after opening of proposal during the validity period or any extension thereof.
- III. If the bidder tries to influence the evaluation process.
- IV. If the first ranked bidder withdraws his proposal prior to signing of contract or fails or refuses to furnish the performance security in accordance with instruction to the bidders.
- V. For contravention of any of the conditions of the NIT not acceptable to the employer.

7. Performance Security Deposit:

7.1 Successful bidder shall within one month from the date of conveying acceptance of the tender in his favour in writing, have to deposit sum equal to 10% of the total estimated cost of the PMC work agency charges for the proposed construction work as security for the fulfillment of the contract in the form of a Bank Guarantee (**in the prescribed format in Annexure VIII**) drawn in favour of the **Pay and Accounts Officer (Sectt.), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Nirman Bhavan**. The Performance Security Deposit shall have to be valid up to a period of 60 days beyond the defect liability period of the facilities created under the project.

8. Submission of Proposals:

8.1 Two Bid System: The original Technical Proposal shall be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked “**TECHNICAL BID: NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT) FOR SELECTION OF AGENCY FOR CONCEPTUALIZATION, OPERATIONALIZATION AND CONDUCT OF INTERNATIONAL YOGA LEAGUE FOR THE YEAR 2017-18 ON BEHALF OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA, MINISTRY OF AYUSH**” Similarly, the original financial proposal shall be placed in a separate sealed envelope clearly marked “**FINANCIAL BID for NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT) FOR SELECTION OF AGENCY FOR CONCEPTUALIZATION, OPERATIONALIZATION AND CONDUCT OF INTERNATIONAL YOGA LEAGUE FOR THE YEAR 2017-18 ON BEHALF OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA, MINISRTY OF AYUSH**’. The envelopes containing the Technical bid, financial bid and EMD shall be placed into an outer envelope and sealed. This outer envelope shall bear the submission address and “**NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT) FOR SELECTION OF AGENCY FOR CONCEPTULISATION, OPERATIONALISATION AND CONDUCT OF INTERNATIONAL YOGA LEAGUE FOR THE YEAR 2017-18 ON BEHALF OF MINISRTY OF AYUSH, GOVT. OF INDIA**’. It will also mention the name of the AGENCY with address and stamp. The **Ministry of AYUSH** shall not be responsible for misplacement, losing or premature opening if the outer envelope is not sealed and /or marked as stipulated. This circumstance may be reason for rejection of the bid. If the financial Proposal is not submitted in a separate sealed envelope duly marked as indicated above, this will constitute grounds for declaring the proposal non-responsive.

8.2 Technical Bids will consist of –

- i. Copy of NIT & clarifications issued by Ministry of AYUSH to this NIT, if any, duly signed and stamped on each page by the authorized signatory of the AGENCY as a mark of acceptance of all conditions of the NIT
- ii. Cost of the NIT and processing fee of Rs. 1000 through bank draft / bankers cheque. (Non – refundable)
- iii. Prescribed Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)
- iv. All Documents as more specifically mentioned in Para 5.1 of this NIT
- v. Information in **Annexure III to VIII**. Technical bids not meeting this requirement or incomplete in any respect will not be considered and summarily rejected.

8.3 Financial Bids will consist of the Agency Charges to be quoted by the AGENCY in the prescribed format at **Annexure-II**. The Financial proposal shall not include any conditions to it and any such conditional financial proposal shall be rejected summarily.

8.3.1 **Taxes:** The Bidders shall fully familiarize themselves about the applicable Domestic taxes (Such as: value added or sales tax, service tax or income taxes, duties, fees, levies) on amounts payable by the Employer under the Contract. Service tax/Swaachh Bharat cess/Krishi kalyan cess must be excluded by the bidders in the financial proposal.

8.4 While Technical Bids will be opened on the date and time given in para 10.1 below, financial Bid of only technically qualified Agencies will be opened later on for which separate date and time will be notified on the website of this Ministry.

8.5 The proposal from the interested eligible Agencies shall be accepted at the following address up to **1430 Hrs.** (Indian Standard Time) on **18.04.2017**.

8.6 The proposal may be sent by post or delivered in person on the above mentioned address. The responsibility for ensuring that the proposals are delivered in time would vest with the bidder. Ministry of AYUSH shall not be responsible if the proposals are delivered late or elsewhere.

8.7 Any proposal received by the Employer rather by post or courier service or in person after the specified date and time will not be opened and shall be returned unopened. Ministry of AYUSH, at its discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of the proposals prior to the time of opening of Technical Bids, as it may deem appropriate.

8.8 **Validity of the Bids:** The bids submitted by bidders shall remain valid for a period of **180 days** from the deadline date for submission of bids.

9. Opening of Proposals:

9.1 Ministry of AYUSH shall open the technical Bids at **1500 Hrs. on 18.04.2017** at Conference Room, AYUSH Bhawan, GPO Complex, B Block, INA, New Delhi-110023 in the presence of authorized representatives from participating AGENCYs, who choose to attend. In case the date fixed for opening of the proposals is subsequently declared as holiday by the Government, the proposals will be opened on the next working day with the time and venue remaining unaltered.

10. Evaluation:

10.1 The duly constituted Tender Evaluation Committee shall evaluate the Technical Proposals on the basis of their responsiveness to the Terms of Reference and by applying the evaluation criteria, specified in the NIT. In the first stage of evaluation, a proposal shall be rejected if it is found deficient as per the requirement indicated in the NIT for responsiveness of the proposal. Only responsive proposals shall be further taken up for evaluation. Evaluation of technical proposal will start first and at this stage the financial bid (proposal) will remain unopened. The proposals will be evaluated, based on the eligibility criteria and submission of all the requisite information /documents as asked for in this NIT in para 3, as per **Annexure III**.

10.2. **Presentation by the eligible bidder:** A detailed presentation by the eligible Bidder who clears the technical scrutiny will be held on 19.04.2017. Presentation shall broadly include:

- i. Understanding of the Terms of References.
- ii. Technical approach and methodology,
- iii. Work plan including timelines;
- iv. Maintenance of quality;
- v. Steps to be taken for timely completion of the project, plan B or alternate methods to complete the project in any eventuality;
- vi. Experience of working in the similar projects with appropriate infrastructure.
- vii. Organization and staffing including suitability of the key personnel for the project and any suggestion made by the bidder to improve the terms of reference. This is an illustrative list of items, but not exhaustive. Based on inputs received from the bidders during the presentation, the employer may modify/ amend the terms of reference, staffing schedule, work schedule, logistics, and reporting subsequently. These documents will then be incorporated in the Contract as **'Description of Assignment/ Job.'** Special attention will be paid to clearly define the inputs and facilities required from the employer to ensure satisfactory implementation of the Assignment/job.

10.3 Evaluation shall be made **under Combined Quality cum Cost Based System (CQCCBS)**. Under CQCCBS, the **technical proposals will be allotted weightage of 70%** and only AGENCY securing a minimum of **60%marks** in technical evaluation shall be considered technically qualified. Financial proposals of only those agencies who are technically qualified shall be opened publicly on the

date & time specified to be notified, in the presence of the agency's representative who choose to attend. The name of the agency, their technical score (if deemed necessary by the employer) and their financial proposal shall be read aloud. **Financial proposals will be allotted weightage of 30%.**

10.4 Proposal with the lowest cost of one time consultancy charges may be given a financial score of 100 and other proposals will be given financial score that is inversely proportional to their prices.

10.5 The total score, both technical and financial, shall be obtained by weighing the quality and cost scores and adding them up.

10.6 **Highest point's basis:** On the basis of the combined weighted score for quality and cost, the AGENCY shall be ranked in terms of the total score obtained. The proposal obtaining the highest total combined score in evaluation of quality and cost will be ranked as H-1 followed by the proposals securing lesser marks as H-2, H-3 etc. In case H-1 bidder withdraws, second highest bidder H-2 will be considered.

11. Agency charges.

11.1 Ministry of AYUSH shall approve concept which shall be prescribed for each stage of ITL and the detailed work plans. The agencies will have to quote one time consulting charges proposed to be charged by them in the financial bids.

11.2 Ministry will not reimburse any charges to the successful bidder towards legal fees, advertisements, third party certification fees, proof checking agency charges, travel expenses, incidental expenses or any other expenditure incurred for the execution of the project other than the statutory fees paid by the bidder to the statutory authorities.

12. Award of Contract

12.1 After Completing the evaluation and consultation as laid down in para 10.6, the employer shall issue a Letter of intent to the selected agency and promptly notify all other agencies who have submitted proposals about the decision taken.

12.2 The selected AGENCY through its authorized representative will sign the contract after fulfilling all the formalities within 15 days of issuance of the letter of intent.

12.3 **Terms of Payments:** Terms of payments will be included in the form of contract after due deliberation with the successful Bidder.

13. Confidentiality.

13.1 Information relating to evaluation of proposals and recommendations concerning awards shall not be disclosed to the AGENCIES who submitted the

proposals or to other persons not officially concerned with the process, until the publication of the award of Contract. The undue use by any Agency of confidential information related to process may result in the rejection of its proposal and may be subject to the provision of the Government's antifraud and corruption policy.

14. Disclaimer

14.1 The information contained in this NIT or subsequently provided to applicants, whether verbally or in documentary or any other form by or on behalf of Ministry of AYUSH, or any its employees or advisers, is provided to applicants on the terms and conditions set out in this NIT and such other terms and conditions subject to which such information is provided.

14.2 This NIT is not an agreement. This NIT provides interested parties with information that may be useful to them in formulation of their proposals pursuant to this NIT. This NIT includes statements, which reflect various assumptions and assessments arrived at by the Ministry of AYUSH, in relation to the construction work. Such assumptions, assessments and statements do not purport to contain all the information that each Applicant may require. This NIT may not be appropriate for all persons, and it is not possible for the Ministry of AYUSH, its employees or advisers to consider the objectives, technical expertise and particular needs of each party who reads or uses this NIT. The assumptions, assessments, statements and information contained in this NIT, may not be complete, accurate, adequate or correct. Each Applicant should, therefore, conduct its own investigations and analysis and should check the accuracy, adequacy, correctness, reliability and completeness of the assumptions, assessments and information contained in this NIT and obtain independent advice from appropriate sources. 14.5 The Ministry of AYUSH may in its absolute discretion, but without being under any obligation to do so, update, amend or supplement the information, assessment or assumption contained in this NIT.

14.6 The Ministry of AYUSH reserves right to accept or reject any or all proposal (s) or to annul the NIT process and reject all proposals at any time prior to award of contract without assigning any reason whatsoever and without thereby incurring any liability to the affected AGENCY (s) on the ground of such action.

14.7 The Applicant shall bear all costs associated with or relating to the preparation and submission of its Proposal including but not limited to preparation, copying, postage, delivery fees, expenses associated with any demonstrations or presentations which may be required by the Ministry of AYUSH, or any other costs incurred in connection with or relating to its Proposal. All such costs and expenses will remain with the Applicant and the Ministry of AYUSH shall not be liable in any manner whatsoever for the same or for any other costs or other expenses incurred by an Applicant in preparation for submission of the proposal, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Selection Process.

14.8 Any effort by a AGENCY to influence the proposal comparison / evaluation / work award decision by way of overt/covert canvassing shall result in non-consideration / rejection of its proposal.

14.9 The Ministry of AYUSH reserves the right to change the schedule of dates / time stated in this NIT. Changes, if any, will be displayed on the website of Ministry of AYUSH and it shall be the responsibility of the Agency to keep themselves abreast of such updates. As such the AGENCIES are requested to regularly check the website of Ministry of AYUSH

14.10 In case of any dispute, jurisdiction of courts in New Delhi will apply.

14.11 The responsibility of giving truthful information without concealing any facts is that of the AGENCY (s). In case, at any stage, it is found that any information given by the AGENCY(s) is false / incorrect / concealed, then Ministry of AYUSH shall have the absolute right to take any action as deemed fit including but not limited to dropping the bidding AGENCY from consideration for award of work / blacklisting etc. without incurring any liability to the affected AGENCY(s) on the ground of Ministry of AYUSH's action.

15. Payment Terms: As the concept of the league is under discussion, payment terms will be finalized with the selected bidder. The position of the fund flows will

be clear only after the finalization of the entire concept. Therefore, the payment terms will be finalized in the contract agreement.

16. Liquidated damages: The LD will be finalized in the contract agreement as per the provisions in the GFR 2005.
