These Nominated candidates may be given admission only after obtaining certificate from them to the effect that they are permanent Government Servants and not on contract basis.

3. The above nominations have been made on the basis of the Deficiency Status available in the records of the Ministry as well as deficiency submitted by State/UTs.

4. The above institution is requested to admit nominated Central Government Nominees (CGN) as per provisions of the CGN guidelines, 2022-23 quoted above in this regard. They may also ensure that no nominee/candidate is provided the subject which is available in their respective State/UT. Further, it is to inform you that the vacant seats in Central Pool under the Central Government Nomination Scheme for MD (Homoeopathy) for academic session 2022-23 shall be filled by AACCC of Ministry of Ayush as per the provision of the Scheme. Therefore, you are requested to inform the data of vacant seat to AACCC, Ministry of Ayush (aaccc-admn-ayush@gov.in) so that the vacant seat can be filled in time.
